Application to Begin the Clinical Year:

Students must first apply to the University and upon acceptance, will be directed to submit supplemental materials as required by the Wegmans School of Nursing. Formal 2+2 applicants must submit all nursing application materials no later than April 1 for fall admission (September start) and September 1 for spring admission (January start).

- To be *considered* for admission to the clinical portion of the program students must achieve a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75.
- Nursing prerequisite GPA of at least 2.4 (average of all attempts of the seven prerequisite courses listed above)
- Ethics, with a grade of C or higher, must be completed prior to beginning the program.
- Note: Cumulative GPA is calculated using all undergraduate college level course work.
- Score 84% or higher on the Math Assessment Level A exam (two attempts allowed).

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
