

## Undergraduate BS: Childhood Education

## Course Requirements:

**Recommended:** Fulfill remainder of associate degree requirements.

Students seeking Childhood Education certification with Middle School Extension in the Content Area Grades 7-9 must major in both Childhood Education and a major/or concentration in their teaching discipline (American Studies, History, English, French, Spanish or Statistics). Students should choose one content area major and complete as many courses listed below as needed to fulfill program elective requirements. Students must complete at least half of their intended major at Fisher. The second major may require candidates to complete more than the minimum 120 credits required for degree completion.

Students seeking Childhood Education certification (Grades 1-6) without Middle School Extension must major in both Childhood Education and another approved liberal arts major or concentration (Philosophy, Religious Studies, Mathematics, Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Sociology, Political Science, Psychology, Anthropology or Economics). The second major may require candidates to complete more than the minimum 120 credits required for degree completion. Students seeking certification without Middle School Extension must contact the Office of Transfer and Graduate Admissions to discuss options/requirements in more detail.

<b>AMERICAN STUDIES</b>	Choose up to five courses from the following with no more than two courses from each of the following three groupings: 1. ECO 203, 204; POS 100; SOC 203. 2. ENG 221, 222. 3. HIS 105, 106, 107
<b>BIOLOGY</b>	Biology BIO 151, 152; CHE 171, 172; MAT 118 or MAT 151
<b>ENGLISH Literature</b>	REQUIRED: Literature Concentration: Choose three courses from: ENG 221, 222, 223, 224; and one 200 level ENG literature courses.
<b>FRENCH</b>	REQUIRED: FRE RECOMMENDED: One course in another language;
<b>HISTORY</b>	HIS 103, 104, 105, 106, one additional HIS course from the following: HIS 207, 208, 209, 212, 213, 223, 224, 261
<b>MATHEMATICS</b>	MAT 161, 162, 263, 241, 251, 264.
<b>SPANISH</b>	REQUIRED: SPA RECOMMENDED: One course in another language;

**NOTE:** Grade of C or higher required in all courses used toward Education major required by St. John Fisher. Cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher required for continuation at Fisher.
